## What We Feature on the Adafruit Blog



## What We Do Not Feature on the Adafruit Blog

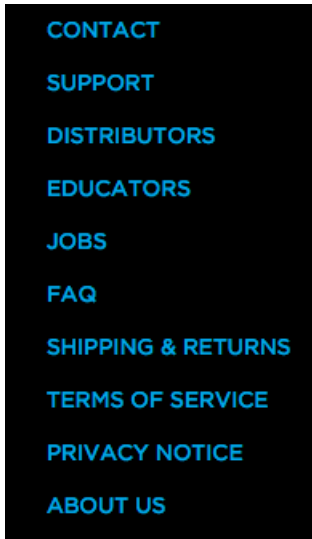
